

Niagara Falls spinal surgeon expands practice

A Niagara Falls spine surgery practice has completed a move into expanded offices, relaunching with a new name and additional treatment options.

ReVive Spine Center is the new name for Spine Surgery of Buffalo Niagara, a clinical practice led by Dr. Franco Vigna.

Located across Williams Road from its previous location in the Summit Health Complex, reVive Spine is housed in a building that formerly hosted a Perkins, a Denny's and most recently, Yianni's Restaurant. Vigna invested \$1.1 million to renovate the 5,000-square-foot facility, completing the move in March.

Already, the new space has allowed for an increase in patient volume, decreased

wait times and improved efficiency. With 1,500 more square feet than its previous location, the practice has added an Integrity spinal decompression machine to treat neck and lower back pain, herniated discs, sciatica, degenerative disc disease and back injuries. It is just the second such machine in use across the state.

Vigna's practice also offers in-house X-ray, pain management, psychology and massage therapy. He said in a prepared statement the expansion allows a more comprehensive approach to spinal care.

"Our new name – reVive Spine Center – speaks directly to our Center's mission from day one – renewing our patients and giving them their lives back," Vigna said.

The rebranding and a new web site are expected to go live on Thursday, in time for a grand opening reception at the site.
